## TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

---

- I-9 Documentation (Right to Work)
- Must not have participated in a previous InTech training in the last 12 months
- Reliable Internet Access
- Laptop (Processor = 3.3 ghz, Ram = 16 gb)
- Webcam (must be on for all sessions)
- Must expect to spend approximately 12 hours per week on live instruction, lab, projects and assignments
- **Only 16 spots available for this program!**

## TRAINING SCHEDULE

### Dates:

June 8, 2020 - September 10, 2020

### Days & Times:

**Lecture - Monday through Thursday, 1.5 Hours Each Day**

**One-on-One with Trainer - Minimum of 30 Minutes per Week**

Time will be determined by student & trainer

**Soft Skills - One Day a Week, Minimum 2 Hours**

Time will be determined by trainer prior to program starting
